
Dear Lt. Patchett:

In conjunction with our investigation into the assassination of President Kennedy, I understand that Mr. Wolf, Deputy Chief Counsel of our Legal Unit, has discussed with you the subpoena sent to the Los Angeles Police Department pertaining to your investigation into the assassination of Senator Robert F. Kennedy. Mr. Wolf indicated to you that it might be helpful for you to have, when you examine the index of your investigation to comply with the subpoena, a list of some of those individuals the Committee believes might be within the scope of the subpoena. Accordingly, I have attached a list of approximately 175 names of individuals who we would be interested in determining whether or not the investigation into the assassination of Senator Kennedy referenced them at any point. If any of these individuals are listed in the index to that investigation, we would appreciate receiving a xerox copy of that index page, and the substantive pages of the report referenced in the index. It is my understanding that this is what you are doing in conjunction with the first item of the subpoena concerning Mr. James Braden.
