Dear Miss McCaslin,

This will reply to your letter of the 3rd. In my previous letter, I enclosed the errata, specifically retyped in the format of the Subject Index itself so that it could be xeroxed and included with the bound pages. I trust that this is possible and that your offer to retype the errata was based on the assumption that the page size was not suitable.

I had not intended that the corrections should be made on the pages of the Subject Index, but only that the errata should be included in the bound xerographic copies. I had assumed that you already had a copy of the Subject Index available for xerography but in the light of your request of the 3rd I am sending you under separate cover my personal copy of the Subject Index.

I would have liked to see a bound xerographic copy, just out of curiosity, but since it is not your policy please forget the request.

One more thing: I have already told several persons who called me hoping to obtain a copy of the Subject Index that application should be made to University Microfilms. However, I was unable to indicate the price. Please let me know in due course so that I can provide that information in response to future inquiries.
