One problem I think you didn't point out in discussing the Tague bullet was that it is possible for a fourth bullet to be fired by one man if the shot that hit Kennedy on 313 was the next-to-last shot. One could select a good deal of testimony that there was a shot after Kennedy was hit in the head, and a number of witnesses heard four shots. Ergo, 4 shots does not disprove "One Man Alone" thesis, Although it raises questions.

I want a chance to read your material more carefully and will return it within a few days.

I don't plan to be in NY again until my thesis is finished. I will, however, make my thesis available to you as soon as it is completed.
