LLOYD A. NELSON, 6736 Putting Green Drive, Dallas, Texas, employed by Mutual of Omaha, 211 North Ervay Building, Dallas, Texas, advised that at about 10:15 on Friday morning, November 22, 1963, prior to the assassination he had observed a man wearing hunting gear and carrying a rifle crossing North Beckley in the general vicinity of 1026 North Beckley and in the general direction of the Humble Service Station located at the intersection of Beckley and Zangs Boulevard. He said he had no information which would associate this individual with the address 1026 North Beckley where it has been established that LEE HARVEY OSWALD had resided.

NELSON provided the following physical description of the individual whom he had observed:

Clothing	Khaki hunting pants of new appearance; a "shell" vest; carrying what appeared to be a new pair of olive green hip waders; carrying what appeared to be a rifle or possibly a shotgun - NELSON stated it could have been a shotgun.

NELSON said that he had observed this individual while driving and as he had turned on Beckley off Zangs travelling south, the man crossed the street in front of the NELSON vehicle.
