RALPH GARLAND, 4202 Live Oak, Dallas, Texas, an employee of the Camp Funeral Home, same address, furnished the following information:

Mr. GARLAND stated that on November 22, 1963, he picked up the body of the son of Mr. and Mrs. RICHARD LeCLAIR, Sturgeon Bay, Wisconsin, and was probably the individual identified as having entered the rear of the Camp Funeral Home with a rifle. He stated a B-B gun is kept on the premises and used to scare pigeons from the roof at the rear of the building. He advised he cannot specifically remember having used the gun behind the building at about 11:00 A.M., November 22, 1963, but that he has done so almost daily for the past three or four weeks, and quite probably did so on that date.
