Previous investigation in the case entitled, "ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNELY NOVEMBER 22, 1963, DALLAS, TEXAS" has established that BONALD WATNE HOUSE, 404 Lula Street, Ranger, Texas, arrived in Dallas, Texas, approximately 10:30 AM on November 22, 1963, and parked his car, a 1957 Ford, green and white, 1963 Texas License DT 4857 in an unrecalled parking lot on Commerce Street in Dallas.

As previously reported in the above-referred to investigation, HOUSE was interviewed at the Fort Worth Police Department on November 23, 1563, at which time he advised that immediately after the Presidential parade he returned to his car and headed for Fort Worth, Texas. He denied having any firearms with him from the time he left his home at Ranger, Texas, at 8:00 AM on Movember 22, 1963, and denied any knowledge of the shooting of President KENNEDY.
