Mr. FRANK LAURANT, 5818 Belmont, Dallas, Texas, advised that on November 22, 1963, during the early afternoon hours, he observed a young white boy about 22 or 23 years of age go into the driveway directly across the street from him, 5819 Belmont, Dallas, Texas, remove a rifle or shotgun from the automobile and enter this residence. He stated this individual was not known to him and in view of the fact he had heard over the radio that President KENNEDY had been assassinated earlier that day, immediately notified the Dallas Police Department. He stated shortly after calling the Dallas Police Department, squad car bearing two officers interviewed the young man in the front yard of 5819 Belmont for a period of about 20 minutes and thereafter left the residence taking no apparent action against the boy.

LAURANT advised 5819 Belmont Street is a residence type building converted into apartments and he knows no one residing in the building. He pointed out he had no reason whatscever to suspect the young boy to have anything to do with the assassination of President KENNEDY other than the fact he had a firearm in his possession and that is the reason he had notified the Dallas Police Department.
