LUCY JOHNSON, 5804 Belmont Street, Dallas, Texas, advised that on November 22, 1963, officers of the Dallas Police Department came to her residence to use her telephone and report to their headquarters that they had just checked out one of the tenants at 5819 Belmont and determined that this person was not connected in any way with the assassination of President KENNEDY. She stated she mentioned to the officers that 5819 Belmont is a private residence converted into apartments and that she manages all of the apartments at that address. According to Mrs. JOHNSON, the officers told her that one of her tenants, WAYNE MARRS, had been reported to have had a rifle or shotgun in his possession, but that they had established that although he did have a rifle in his automobile, such was in his legal possession and at the time the President was assassinated, MARRS had been in Corsicana, Texas, where he had borrowed the rifle to go hunting.

Mrs. JOHNSON advised MARRS has since moved and that she does not know his current address, place of employment, or any background information concerning him.
