THEODORE H. FREEMAN, Chief, Plant Protection, General Motors Corporation, Arlington, Texas, was interviewed in his office.

FREEMAN advised the records of this General Motors plant indicate MALCOLM JERRY HOY was employed on June 4, 1963, as a spot welder and his employment was terminated on May 4, 1964, when he walked off the job without notice.

According to HOY's personnel file, an employment inquiry was received on May 28, 1964, from the General Motors plant at Southgate, California, asking for employment recommendations on HOY as he had apparently applied for work at that General Motors plant. The local employment office on the same day gave unfavorable recommendation on HOY to the Southgate plant.

FREEMAN advised the file does not indicate that HOY was ever hired by the Southgate General Motors plant, but he cannot say for sure that he was not hired.

FREEMAN noted the local personnel file of HOY contains a notation by some unidentified General Motors employer interviewer that he thought HOY was a mental case.

FREEMAN continued noting that HOY apparently arrived in Dallas, Texas, around June, 1963, from 8577 Tidewater Drive, Norfolk, Virginia, which address is also noted on HOY's application as that of his father, WILLIAM THOMAS HOY.

HOY's personnel file contains the following local Dallas addresses during his period of residence in this city:

FREEMAN noted that at the time HOY quit, a representative went to his last known address of 4840 Junius Avenue, Dallas, where HOY's former landlady advised that he had left Dallas advising her General Motors was sending him to a mechanic's school in Detroit, Michigan.

FREEMAN noted this remark by HOY about being sent by General Motors to a school in Michigan was untrue.

FREEMAN noted HOY was apparently hired at the time General Motors was setting up a second shift and was taking almost anyone they could get, and, accordingly, was not doing as much of a screening job as they normally do in their hiring.

FREEMAN advised HOY's employment file contains the following limited descriptive data:
