Mrs. DON CORNETT, 107 Sam Hill Drive, Irving, advised SA ARTHUR E. CARTER and Patrolman PRESTON C. SNOGA, of the Irving Police Department, that she is the wife of DON CORNETT, who is employed by the Southwest General Insurance Company with offices in the Republic National Bank Building, Dallas, Texas, telephone BL 5-7530 (residence), and Mr. CORNETT's office telephone is RI 2-3421.

She said she recalled that on the evening of November 21, 1963, she and her husband drove to the vicinity of Lindy Lane and Peveto in Irving about 7:15 or 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of buying some tropical fish which they had seen advertised in the paper. She said as they drove into Lindy Lane from Nursery Street, they reached a little crook in Lindy Lane close to the intersection of Peveto, when they heard three loud shots in rapid succession which apparently came from in front of their car or east of them. She said she was quite disturbed; and especially on November 22, after hearing of the assassination of President KENNEDY, she thought this might have some significance.

She said that she and her husband had returned to the area very briefly and had observed a wooded lot near the intersection of Peveto and Lindy Lane and thought that the noise they heard which they believed to be rifle shots might have come from that area. She said she recalled there was a party going on in a house on the corner at the intersection of Nursery and Lindy Lane, but she did not think it possible that the sound could have come from that direction as it would have been to the rear of their car.

She said she had never known of LEE HARVEY OSWALD or JACK RUBY until after news of the President's assassination and that she had never seen anyone resembling either of them at any time except on television programs.
