Major LEON POWERS, Assistant Chief of Police, Irving, Texas, searched the records of that department and made inquiry of members of this department. He determined there was no record of DON CORNETT, of 1007 Sam Hill Drive, North Gate Addition, Irving, Texas.

Major POWERS advised that he also searched his office records and determined that no information or complaints had been received on November 21, 1963, by since that time concerning any disturbance caused or illegal firing of firearms in the residential area of Irving, Texas, in the vicinity of Lindy Lane and Paveto. He advised that he would assign Patrolman PRESTON C. SNOGA, of the Irving Police Department, to accompany agent to the residential area in an attempt to determine whether or not any residents of that area knew of any unusual disturbance such as the firing of highpowered rifles which might have occurred on the night of November 21, 1963.

He added that the area where DON CORNETT resides at 1007 Sam Hill Drive is occupied by medium to high-priced three to four bedroom brick homes in a new residential area.
