Patrolman PRESTON C. SNOGA, Badge No. 34, Irving Police Department, advised that he has patrolled the area of Peveto and Lindy Lane in Irving, and during his patrol duty he has observed there are no large wooded areas anywhere close to the intersection of Peveto and Lindy Lane. He said it is noted that there are two small wooded vacant lots near the intersection of Peveto and Lindy Lane; however, they are on opposite sides of Lindy Lane, and neither of them is large enough for a person to fire a high-powered rifle in.

He stated there are some large open fields and one heavily wooded field in an area about a mile or one and one-fourth miles from the intersection of Peveto and Lindy Lane and stated this area could be reached by driving from Peveto south on Lindy Lane to Nursery, thence left to the wooded area.

He said he was familiar with the investigations that have been conducted in the assassination of President KENNEDY and recalled that Mrs. OSWALD resided with some people in Irving whose home is three or four miles from the woods and farm area indicated above.

He further advised that the youngsters who live in the area around Peveto and Lindy Lane do a lot of small arms hunting in the fields he has described.
