Mrs. VICTOR ADAMS, 1121 Lindy Lane, Irving, Texas, advised SA ARTHUR E. CARTER and Patrolman PRESTON C. SNOGA, Badge No. 34 of the Irving Police Department, that she recalled she was at home with her children on the entire evening of November 21, 1963, from 6:00 p.m. until they retired, and she said her home is located only three lots removed from the intersection of Peveto and Lindy Lane, and there are only two small vacant lots in the area, one directly across from Peveto on one side of Lindy Lane, and the other lot is on the Peveto side of Lindy Lane one lot removed from Peveto. She noted that both of these are small narrow lots and the area is densely populated with people in small low rent dwellings. She said she definitely did not hear anyone shooting on the night of November 21, 1963, and questioned other members of her family who also advised they did not hear any shots on that evening.

Mrs. ADAMS said that children often shoot air rifles and .22's in the oak trees in the area, but she does not recall any highpowered rifles being fired immediately adjacent to her residence and believes most of the shots are fired in fields about one and one-fourth to two miles away from her residence toward Nursery Street in Irving. She advised there was no one at home at 1126 Lindy Lane, and she did not know the names of any of the other residents in the immediate area.
