ELWOOD C. AUSTIN, 402 West Crawlyer Street, Irving, Texas, telephone BL 3-7976, on December 6, 1963, advised SA JAMES W. ANDERTON that he is a former police officer from Las Vegas and wished to furnish some information concerning a target range located near his house. Mr. AUSTIN stated that he definitely has not observed LEE HARVEY OSWALD at this range but thought it very possible he could have used the range in testing a rifle.

AUSTIN stated the range is actually an abandoned gravel pit and to reach the range one should drive west on Rock Island Road, past Beltline Road until Rock Island Road deadends at a washed-out bridge. He stated then one must walk approximately 150 yards southwest on a path to the gravel pit. He stated not many people know about this range, but that the times he has been out there several individuals have been firing both pistols and rifles. He stated the range is immediately south of the Greater Southwest Airport.
