BERT GLOVER, 3129 Williamsburg, Irving, Texas, employed as a barber at Irving, advised that on about Sunday, October 27, at 4:30 PM while hunting on the Trinity River bottom near Irving, he had heard three rifle shots in a burst in that area. He stated that he had seen no one whom he might associate with the shots and had no other information except that the shots appeared to have come from that area north of the railroad viaduct east of Irving and on the east side of the Trinity River. This area he said is approached from East 6th Street in Irving.

Mr. GLOVER stated that he was bringing this to the attention of the FBI inasmuch as he felt that it might assist in locating the area where LEE HARVEY OSWALD might have test fired his rifle.
