A physical check of the railroad right-of-way of the Missouri, Kansas and Texas Railroad from the downtown area of Dallas to approximately four miles north of General EDWIN A. WALKER's residence, 4011 Turtle Creek Boulevard, failed to locate a field or open area where a person could target practice with either a rifle or pistol. It was noted that the entire route is composed of residential and commercial buildings to a close proximity of the railroad tracks.

This check also encompassed a three or four-mile radius of the railroad which would include the Love Field area.
