On January 2, 1964, an anonymous telephone call was received at the Dallas FBI Office, at which time a male voice stated that a man by the name of STACY, 2518 Catherine Street, Dallas, Texas, had been showing him some guns and stated that this man, STACY, puts telescopic sights on guns and inferred that he may have had something to do with the telescopic sight on the weapon used in the assassination of President KENNEDY.

The 1963 Dallas City Directory reflects a JAMES O. STACY, wife ANNA R., employed as a gunsmith for Moore and Carpenter, 325 North Akard Street. STACY's residence is reflected as 2518 Catherine Street.
