Scope Sight on Assassination Rifle

The following investigation was conducted by
SA ROBERT S. MAKER:

AT SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA

SIMON ZERVOS, 1825 La Jolla Rancho Road, La Jolla, (a suburb of San Diego, California), on December 1, 1963, advised he had recently read or heard over the radio or television that the weapon used to assassinate President JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY was fitted with a scope sight manufactured by Pantech, Incorporated.

Mr. ZERVOS stated that in May of 1963, he purchased Pantech, Incorporated, of Solana Beach, California, from C. R. L. Industries, Bedford, Massachusetts. He said many of the Pantech company records were turned over to him, and he would be willing to check these records in an effort to establish whether or not LEE HARVEY OSWALD was a past customer of the company.

Mr. ZERVOS, on December 3, 1963, was advised that the assassination weapon and scope sight were purchased from Klein's, Chicago, Illinois.
