

Wade's "concern" about statements in the press to the effect that there was no link between Oswald and Ruby is interesting, in the light of his later conduct of the prosecution in the Ruby trial. Perhaps he suspected but was unable to establish such a link. Actually, his "concern" was prudent and logical, and would occasion no comment were it not for the fact that Wade on 11/22-24/63 was scarcely prudent or logical.
