On the 18th of June, I sent him an article ("How to Manufacture a Lone Assassin"), which perhaps you might also consider for publication in due course.

May I hope that the same financial terms will apply as in the publication in the 4 April 1970 issue of my article "The Private Life of the Warren Commission"? As I had explained to Mr. Olds, I need to maintain my status as a free-lance writer, for income tax purposes, even if by token payments.
