Dear Mr. Auchincloss,

One more word on the autopsy sketch, if I may: it was not made by the Secret Service or FBI observers who attended the autopsy--on the contrary, it was made by the autopsy surgeon as an integral part of the autopsy report and an illustration of the narrative portions. The sketch to which I referred is a part of Commission Exhibit No. 397, which bears the title,

"Comdr. James J. Humes' handwritten autopsy report on President Kennedy and certificates regarding the disposition of working papers and preliminary drafts of the autopsy report."

You will find this in the Hearings, Volume XVII, pages v and 29-48 (the sketch itself is on page 46).
