The President's Commission by letter dated July 31, 1964, referred to the report of Special Agent ROBERT P. GEMBERLING dated February 11, 1964, Pages 87, 92, and 93, containing interviews of HAROLD RUSSELL, ROBERT BROCK and Mrs. MARY BROCK. The President's Commission requested that affidavits be obtained from each of these individuals specifying his interview represented a correct report of what each witness saw on November 22, 1963.

On August 4, 1964, KEN CARPENTER, Manager, Johnny Reynolds Motor Company, 500 East Jefferson, Dallas, Texas, advised Special Agent A. On August 4, 1964, Mrs. F.B. HAWKINS, 327 South Windomere Street, Dallas, Texas, advised Special Agent A. RAYMOND SWITZER that HAROLD FAY RUSSELL formerly rented a room from her, but has returned to Davis, Oklahoma, to take care of some family affairs. She stated he occasionally visits Dallas, and she last saw him about a month ago. She said his mailing address is Box 105, Davis, Oklahoma.
