last night in a recorded interview was asked about his opinion
of lee harvey oswald, alleged murderer of president kennedy. inter-
viewer was dutch journalist willem oltmans. the time he had
de mohrenschiltdt said that oswald during the time he had
contact with him was an+objective and very level-headed person+
and not +a nut+, not +nervous and dissatisfied+, +no lunatic+ and
+far from being uneducated+.
de mohrenschiltdt said he did not know what happened to
oswald during the time he had not seen him which was a period of
about two years preceding the murder. but he thought it very
unlikely that oswald would have changed so much as to become the
+unbalanced and lunatic+ person he now was generally seen.
de mohrenschiltdt said his relations with oswald were based
on their common interest for russia where oswald had been staying
at minsk, home town of de mohrenschiltdt who said he had a very
high opinion of oswald +who was no enemy of president kennedy, whose
to the contrary admired him, found him an excellent president, whose
ideas corresponded with those of oswald himself+.
preceding the interview, a commentator said that de mohrenschiltdt
in a letter to the kennedy family had described oswald as +an
exponent of the cancer of juvenile criminality spreading in the
