## Two Wallace Daughters Quickly Learn Details

BIRMINGHAM, Ala., May 15 (AP)—One of Gov. George C. Wallace's two grown daughters learned he had been shot while she was at home tending his only grandchild. The other found out about the attack while attending a college course.

Within minutes after the shots were fired in Laurel, Md., an Alabama state trooper car was dispatched to the home of Mrs. Bobbie Jo Parsons in a suburb south of Birmingham.

Peggy Sue Wallace, a senior in college, was in a class-room at Troy, Ala., State University when she heard of the shooting.
