SUBJECT: Assassination of President John F. Kennedy

1. Your memorandum dated 6 December 1963, file DL 100-10461, reports the results of an interview of Marina OSWALD at Dallas, Texas, on 3 December 1963 by Special Agents Wallace R. Heitman and Anatole Boguslav. The memorandum lists 47 photographs which were among the effects of Lee Harvey OSWALD, and made available to your Bureau by Captain J. W. Fritz of the Dallas Police Department. She provided identifying information. It appears that most of the photographs were taken in the USSR and depict Soviet contacts of OSWALD or scenes in the Soviet Union.

2. In connection with our efforts to assist the President's Commission on the Assassination of President Kennedy by providing information which might be helpful in interpreting available materials relating to OSWALD's activities abroad, we would appreciate receiving at your earliest convenience one copy of each of these photographs, exemplars, from which we can make copies.
