JOHN HARPER, Fress Secretary to Governor CARL SANDERS, State Capitol Building, advised that at 2:02 p.m. on November 22, 1963, Miss JUDY DARBY, Receptionist for the Governor, had received a collect telephone call from an unknown man calling from Macon, Georgia.

The caller stated "You know what happened to President KENNEDY?" The caller then made several disconnected statements and became somewhat incoherent. He stated, "I'm one of the governor's boys. 1'll see the governor, you can count on that, you can count on that."

Miss DAREY advised HAEPER that the unknown man had a menacing voice and could have been intoxicated.

Mr. HARPER advised that the Georgia Bureau of Investigation was actively investigating this call and that both the Atlanta Police Department and the U.S. Secret Service, Atlanta, had been advised.
