Dear Mr. Sanders:

On behalf of the Commission, I would like to thank you for the cooperation extended by you and your staff to representatives of the Commission in Dallas during the past two weeks.

Two members of the staff, Joseph A. Ball and David H. DeLin, will be in Dallas for about ten days commencing March 31. We have scheduled depositions with various witnesses on Wednesday, April 1, and Thursday, April 2. We have asked witnesses to call into the U. S.
