I enclose herewith the transcript of your Long John radio interview, which was prepared by Jerry Policeff.

As we discussed, I enclose also a draft "OP-ED" article based on the transcript. I have kept the length well within the average limits of the space given to such OP-ED articles in the NY Times, so as not to give any pretext for rejecting it as too lengthy. After you have made any corrections or revisions you wish, I suggest you send it with a covering letter listing all your titles to Harrison Salisbury, Editor, OP-ED page, NY Times, 229 West 43 Street, NY, NY 10036, marking the envelope "FOR PERSONAL ATTENTION" or something like that.

If Salisbury rejects it, I believe it should next be submitted to The Saturday Review, which has in the past been generally receptive to criticism of the WR. Of course, they have recently changed editors, and perhaps editorial policy, too, but it is worth a try. After that, we can try the NY Review of Books.
