Thank you for sending me copies of your recent correspondence with Thomas Stamm and Vincent Salandria.

With regard to the former, I simply cannot get involved in meaningful correspondence with him on this matter, and I would appreciate your assistance in explaining this to him. Incidentally, I do not recall saying that the rifle stock was "split". I did mention that the stock was not in good condition. I believe that I am right on this point?

I read your letter to Salandria with great interest, and I continue to be amazed at your patience and willingness to spend so much time in corresponding with so many people on various aspects of this entire matter.

My own theory as to who was primarily responsible for the assassination is completely in agreement with yours. With regard to the possible involvement of the CIA, there is no doubt in my mind that they subsequently learned much (if not all) of what had transpired, and they are, therefore, as you have so aptly labeled them, accessories after the fact. I just wonder whether or not they had (or should have had) some knowledge in advance of what was being plotted in Dallas for that day.
