Dear Sylvia:

I certainly understand the reason for your bafflement, as set forth in your letter of January 15th. You are right, of course. The sketches and captions are quite misleading.


The Editors at MODERN MEDICINE added these in at the very end of our collaboration. Although they described them to me by phone, I did not actually see the captioned data. What they failed to point out is that the second sketch (page 31) sets forth what the trajectory would have had to have been if Oswald had shot the President from the 6th floor of the TSBD. Since the back wound was not (as you have correctly stated in your letter) as high as it is shown in the second sketch, I believe that we have additional evidence that Oswald did not shoot the President in the back from the 6th floor window of the TSBD.

I would like to prepare a much more detailed and lengthy article for the Journal of Forensic Sciences concerning all my findings and conclusions, and I hope that somehow I shall find the time to do so within the next few months.

I hope that you have had no recurrences of your medical problems of last year, and that everything is going well for you in all respects.
