Dear Cyril,

Thank you for your letter of the 8th. Yes, it is curious that the NY Times should have a copy of your article. Perhaps it was sent by Medera Medicine and it may be that they will do a news story when it is published in MM.

If you can get republishing rights, I would suggest that you first try to place the article in a general magazine that would reach a substantial public and only if that fails then try a large-circulation medical journal.

Jones Harris is a person who could help you enormously to place the article in a popular magazine. He is a very very close friend of the editor of the New York Review of Books, for example, and has already told me that they would be entirely open to the publication of an article on the JFK assassination. He also knows the people who run Harpers and, I suspect, many other magazines. He has excellent contacts in the publishing world at large and if he was willing I feel sure he could help you.
