Dear Mr Schwartz,



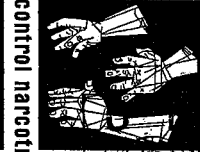
