It may not be as "closed" as he would like, if the New Bedford DA succeeds in getting an inquest, as was reported on the CBS news last night. Another interesting news item on the same broadcast was the reinstatement of Dr. Noguchi. What a peculiar business that was! Do you think it has any connection with the RFK/Sirhan case? Some of the critic types maintain that there were more shots and more bullets than can be attributed to Sirhan or his weapon, and that the powder burns on the clothes are not consistent with Sirhan's location or proximity to RFK during the shooting.

No, the Rennar material was not enclosed with the letter sent to me in New York. As indicated previously, I had already received the material in question from Rennar.

I have now looked more carefullytthrough your book and note that it is to be the first of a series of annuals. It is a most impressive volume and I hope it has every success.
