Dear Mr Weisberg,

We seem to be in close proximity not only on page 31 of THE NEW LEADER but in degree of recoil from the Warren Report. I am very much interested in the book you have written, which you say is unpublished in the USA. Has your book been published abroad? If so, please furnish details.

I am publishing a subject index to the 26 volumes of Hearings and Exhibits; it will come out early in March, I believe, by Scarecrow Press Inc. of New York.

I have written—or, to be more precise, am writing—a book on the Warren Report, in the form of a comparative study of the numerous conflicts between the Report and the testimony and/or documents on which it pretends to be based. Although more than 300 pages are written, much more remains to be done—so numerous the distortions, omissions, and plain falsehoods.

Gradually, this work has brought me into touch with more and more people, in various parts of the country; almost invariably, communication began with expressions of relief at a break in the isolation and the discouragement of seeming to be out of step with the rest of the world. Happily, there are quite a few heretics now, but not enough.
