

Post Mortem III

4x5 exposed film "no image"

roll " " color camera

"black = no image apparent"

- close to a photographic impossibility  
Some image must be on film

"No image" means deliberate destruction

Haines - gave Anthony report

11/24/63 5 pm to Capt. Storer

(no papers remain) Oct

6 pm to Edw. Berkeley

June 1967 H/B/F report

photos 11-12 verify location

back wind, later described  
as photos of head from

above + right

"Entrance" because edges pushed  
inward - but - probed =  
finger.

No X-rays extremities  
made until Finch asked  
for them, now, missing.

1968 Panel - 2 days  
Grossly inadequate & absurd  
for kind of study needed  
for those & no previous  
knowledge

Decejanis in inventories  
& numbering of photos &  
X-rays: false discontinue  
between prints = projections  
transparencies

Failure of Amine negatives  
for alteration

No photos of head mask  
or body taken for front

7 black & white negatives  
of the brain but any  
corresponding prints (why  
didn't they have prints  
made?)

No lateral photos of brain  
No photos sections of skull  
retrieved later
