In today's mail, from each of you, postmarked, prop. 9/2/ 9/6 and 9/2, obviously prepared with care. P/S's was torn opened and the flap tucked in. This was with part of flap missing. 27's was fairly obviously re-glued, last week, from my "published", one that had simply had the flap pulled open and not even re-glued (that one I took to postmaster with request for investigation, as I will do with these).

What appears to be different is as follows:-, however, for the fact is not new, there being occasions, apart from the past, whether or not it helps anything now I'll not venture to predict. It doesn't ~~mean~~ mean that much to me. However, I would suggest that after a short period at least you seal each flap with single tape, which does not tear readily, by sole purpose being that the possibility of ~~accidental~~ taping be reduced to the ~~absolute~~ minimum cannot be overemphasized. Nor will this reduce my use of the mails or my expenses. I encourage you to take the same attitude, be not be intimidated.

Intend also that it is no trick to remove single tape and that it is no prevention of intrusion. It is merely for this limited purpose, to eliminate the possibility of accident to the degree possible, and it is better than ~~double~~ tape.

On the subjects contained in these letters, I will expand as I can. I have nearly finished them. I am anxious to complete a few minor changes in the new last part of P, which 'll be retypes. Then will attack the cutting of the first part, which will have to be extensive and which I may find it difficult to go over a second time (if say have some suggestions and haven't provided them). Then onto with what was originally called III, where more than anything else I suppose it will be the high level of ~~precision~~ that will require editing. Aside from other complications in our lives, the time in which 'll be retypes and read for accuracy and then later the new work is necessarily limited, so please understand the limitation that imposes on precision here.

Strange coincidence while I was writing this my wife had a personal phone call from her (111) sister which was abruptly cut off and replaced with a busy signal. The operator did not come back on the line after a repeated ringing.

I do think the contents of 28 III move us into a different situation, if not one which all three of you can judge. And I think that the potential has to be known, there may be some significance to this either now and even inappropriety. It has a parallel in the detective medium, known as "group shooting", in which the person shot/kill is intended to know it is happening, the "shooter" being the subject will be intimidation.

The new intro for all three parts is completed. It is (32) what I had written for the new third before there was this said possibility of private printing, to which I added about 3,000 words at the front end.

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
