RICHARD L. PIERCE, Research Department, Socony Research Laboratory, 3600 Duncanville Road, Duncanville, Texas, advised he formerly resided with EVERETT GLOVER and VOLKMAR SCHMIDT at 4449 Potomac Avenue, Dallas, Texas.

PIERCE advised that in February, 1963, GLOVER held a dinner party at the above residence. In attendance at this party were Mr. and Mrs. LEE HARVEY OSWALD, Mrs. RUTH PAINE, Irving, Texas, Mr. and Mrs. NORMAN FREDERICKSON, Irving, now a student at the University of Wisconsin, Mr. and Mrs. GEORGE DE MORAENSCHILDT, who are now residing in Haiti, and PIERCE, himself. PIERCE stated he had never met either of the OSWALDs prior to this party and has seen neither since that time. He recalled that OSWALD said he worked for Jeager Press located in downtown Dallas. During the course of the conversation, OSWALD described his travels in Russia and mentioned to PIERCE that while in Russia he worked in a factory in Minsk, Russia. PIERCE recalled that OSWALD did not hesitate in stating he was a Communist and sympathetic to the views of Communism. At no time during the evening were United States politics discussed, and at no time was any comment made concerning any of the KENNEDYs or their policies.

PIERCE stated it is his understanding that GEORGE and JEAN DE MORMENSCHILDT both were Russians, and both claimed to speak Russian fluently. In addition, JEAN DE MORMENSCHILDT claimed to speak Chinese.
