Mrs. A. G. (JANE) BERRY, 3126 Lakton Avenue, Apartment 2, advised she was employed by Scott-Foresman Publishing Company, fourth floor, Texas School Book Depository Building, -411 Elm Street.

At approximately 12:40 p.m., on November 22, 1963, she was standing just west of the building, watching a parade in which President JOHN F. KENNEDY was riding. Just as the car was passing by her, she heard a rifle shot. A few seconds later she heard a second and third shot. She observed President KENNEDY slump over and everyone began falling to the ground or running. She realized that the President had been shot and observed the motorcade in which he was riding immediately speed off in a westerly direction.

Everyone was very excited and no one seemed to know where the shot had come from. It sounded as if it had been fired from a position west of where she was standing.

She soon returned to her office on the fourth floor of the building and began listening to radio reports on the shooting. A few minutes later police officers came to the office investigating the matter, but she was unable to furnish them with any information concerning the person who had fired the shots.

After seeing photographs of LEE HARVEY OSWALD, she could not recall ever having seen him before. She has been working for the above firm about one year and knows many of the older employees in the building by sight.

She could furnish no other pertinent information.
