ROY EDWARD LEWIS, warehouse employee, Texas School Book Depository (TSBD), 411 Elm Street, advised he was working in the warehouse on November 22, 1963, on the date of the assassination of President KENNEDY. He advised he recalls seeing LEE HARVEY OSWALD in the warehouse on one occasion, that being at approximately 10:30 AM, November 22, 1963, on the first floor of the varehouse, where he was filling orders. As he recalls, this was the only time he saw OSWALD on that date. He stated he subsequently viewed the Presidential Motorcade and heard the shots being fired at the President but could offer no information as to where the shots had come from, nor did he observe anything further regarding the activities of LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

LEWIS advised in previous contacts with OSWALD, he considered OSWALD to be a quiet individual and one who kept to himself during his course of employment at the TSED.
