Mrs. PARSONS stated that she did not know LEE HARVEY OSWALD by name but stated that she probably had seen him in the building; however, she was not certain of this.

On February 28, 1964, Mr. HERBERT L. "HERB" JUNKER, salesman, MacMillan Company, room 302, 411 Elm, Dallas, advised that he could furnish no information concerning the assassination of President KENNEDY. He stated that at the time of the assassination he was at the Blue Front Cafe on Elm Street having lunch. He stated that he did not know LEE HARVEY OSWALD.
