I just ran across something that may interest you, in the book The Assassination Tapes by George O'Toole (Penthouse Press, New York, 1975). O'Toole does not deal in any great depth with the autopsy and medical findings, but he does make an interesting suggestion on page 104 of his book. He says:

Assuming the x-rays showed no bullet still in the body, how could the throat wound be anything but an exit wound? The answer that occurs to this writer and may have worried Humes is that the massive entry wound in the back of the head, caused by the final shot, might have obscured a smaller exit wound caused a few seconds earlier by a shot from the grassy knoll striking the president in the throat.
