Did the paper publish your letter? It was good. I enclose where the Lou. Bar Assoc. wrote me up, from the UK Public Info dispatch. They even spelled my name right 50% of the time. Reminds me of the time they wrote an article in the paper and said my father was dead. He got a laugh out of it, but for years people believed the paper instead of me! Dr. Wrone sent me some article he wrote, it is good. He got all his glasses in one piece. The FBI must have given yours a good kick.

After Betsy and I left Frederick, we drove straight to Mt. Vernon. Betsy is a real George Washington fan. Thinking about the treason involved in killing JFK, I cried all the way up the hill to his house. I wonder what Washington would have thought about all this avoiding the truth with the FBI and the Warren Commission?

I kid you occasionnally about all this, because it is so serious, but don't think for a minute I don't take it seriously. I do. I was trained in the classics, four years of Latin in high school, read the Greek tragedies, even was an actor-spear carrier- in a college Greek play. I have come to think of this subject as America's Greek tragedy.

Look at it this way. JFK was from a rich, urban background, went to Harvard. Senator Cooper was from a modest, rural Somerset KY. background, went to Yale.Both became Senators, and Cooper and Kennedy became close friends, partly through their wives, who had known each other. Kennedy began to withdraw from Vietnam when he was murdered. Cooper was I believe Kennedy's only real friend on the Warren Commission, and I believe tried to get at the truth. He failed. In the end, the Cooper-Church Amendment helped end the Vietnam war, Cooper doing what Kennedy could not.

I have always felt that the Cooper-Church was one of the most important bills to ever come out of the Senate. I know of no other legislative body who ever ended a war in that manner.
