1. Reference is made to your letter, dated 19 July 1977, requesting our reply to Mr. Harold Weisberg's letter of 24 June 1977, complaining that this Agency has failed to locate records on the John F. Kennedy assassination and/or himself. Your referral was received in this office on 25 July 1977.
2. In summary, this office has made a good-faith effort of search and explanation of files procedures and has repeatedly provided the following responses to Mr. Weisberg:
 - a. Addressing specifically his request for information relating to the JFK assassination, checks of the Impersonal Title Index of the Defense Central Index of Investigations (DCII) were conducted under various titles relating to the assassination, to determine the existence of any records pertaining to the incident. The results of the DCII checks indicate that no Army intelligence investigative records exist concerning the JFK assassination.
 - b. Regarding the reference to James Powell, Mr. Weisberg has been advised that there are no Army reports, records or photographs of Mr. Powell's presence at the JFK assassination scene.
 - c. A review was made of the history records of the 112th Military Intelligence Group, which maintained offices in the Rio Grande Building, Dallas, Texas in 1963-64. No information was found relating to the JFK assassination.
 - d. This office is responsible for the custody of all intelligence investigative files generated by the US Army. Exhaustive searches of records maintained at this facility have been made; however, no records identifiable with Mr. Weisberg's requests are known to exist.
