1. During the course of a background investigation of a prospective Agency employee by the Security Division, National Security Agency, information was developed that three alleged Government employees are reportedly associating or have associated with the above-captioned individuals.

2. Elles of mother Government egency reflect that Perold-WillSBE was dispissed on 23 June 1947 from the Department of State because of indirect association with representatives of foreign powers. Files further reflect that Mrs. Lillian WEISBENG admitted that both she and how husband were members of an organization cited by the Attorney General.

3. The aforementioned Government employees are as follows: Mae CROWLEY, nee Stolls, a sister of Mrs. Lillion VELSMENT, reportedly | a former employee of Naval Ordnance Laboratory; Ofth CULUEY, husbend | of Mae Stone CROWLEY, reportedly employed by Marat-Granners Laboratory; and Robert STONE, brother of Mrs. Lillion WELSMENT, reportedly a former employee of the Bareau of Consus but reachly transforred to another agency of the Government.
