Re: Privacy Act Appeal

Dear Mr. Weisberg:

This is in response to your letter dated April 27, 1977, received in this Office May 2, 1977, in which you request all records held by the Navy concerning suits brought by you. Your letter is considered a request for an initial determination pursuant to the Privacy Act of 1974 (5 U.S.C. § 552a).

A thorough search of our records indicates that with the exception of one index card, which is being furnished to you, all records concerning your suits held by the Navy were destroyed in October, 1973, along with other records of suits finished filed from 1955-1964. As indicated by the index card, your case was finished filed on February 7, 1962. This destruction of records was in accordance with the Army instruction which has been adopted by the Navy. For your information, we are enclosing the pertinent copy of the Army regulations and the informal concurrence of the Navy.

- Personal property claim files. Case files relating to claims against the Government by members of the Army and the Army National Guard and by civilian employees of the Army and the Department of Defense for damage, loss, or destruction of personal property incident to
- *Destroy 10 years after final action on the case.
- Tort claim files. Case files relating to tort claims against >403-06 the Army for damage, loss, or destruction of property, and for personal injury or death resulting from negligente as wrongful acts or omission of acts by military persenati and civilian employees.
- *Destroy 10 years after final action on the case.
- Noncombal activity claim files. Case files relating to claims against the Government for death and personal injury, or for damage, loss, or destruction of per onal and real property caused by Army and Army National Guard asticary personnel and civilian employees involved in concembat activities.
- *Destroy 10 years after final action on the case.
- Nonswiger of employment claim files. Case files relating 403-08 to distins against the Government not cognizable under any other provision of law, and settled under the act of 9 October 1952 (76 Stat. 767), for damage to, or loss of pragmay, or personal injury or death caused by a member of the Asmy or a civilian employee of the Army, which areae on and after 9 October 1962 incident to the one of a vehicle of the United States at any phase, or any other property of the United States on a Covenness of Eastablation.
