This is in regard to the request of your client, Mr. Harold Meisberg, for certain decoments which relate to FBI Laboratory findings concerning spectrographic and neutron activation analyses in connection with the John F. Kennedy assassination investigation.

I wish to advise you that 17 pages of material are now available for release and include, with one exception, the material Kr. Weisberg made specific request for during a recent discussion he had in your presence with representatives of the FBI. The one exception is the data concerning spectrographic examination of metal smears on a section of a curbatone. We are still in the process of compiling this data and will advise you concerning this as moon as it is possible to do so.

The following is a statement regarding fees we are authorized to charge in accordance with Department of Justice regulations, currently published in the Pederal Register. regulations authorize a charge at the rate of \$1.00 per each one quarter hour apent by clerical personnel, in excess of the first quarter hour, in searching for and producing a requested record. There a search cannot be performed by clerical personnel, charges for the search may be made at a rate of \$2.00 per each one quarter hour spent in excess of the first quarter hour. These regulations authorize copying fees at the rate of ten cents per page. The charges itemized in this case are as follows:
