In the abstracts for the records in Sections 36-91 of 44-33:61 there is a series of "changed to" forms representing the shifting of a number of records pertaining to the King assassination investigation to emother file, 62-117290, where as in all cases they have X in their new serial numbers. They appear to be insertions into existing serialization.

My records indicate that 62-117230 also includes the request of the House assausing committee for my POIA requests.

All of these shifts appear to have been on three different days.

The clear purpose was to remove records I had been promised in U.A. 75-1996 from the MUNKIN file. Otherwise, Not Recorded serials would have been used. I appeal this.

If the records pertain to me or to HSCA, they are within two other requests, one for all records on me, the other for all provided to HSCA.

At this one point 26 MORKIN records are removed, from Serial 6135 to Serial 6235.

Recause this seems unusual and because I regard your prior explanation about removed serials as inadequate and based on an atypical matter I maked No. Barrett to check the records as provided to me. If the blue ink copies at all I will attachs her notes. I do request that you ask the PMI for an explanation, because each and every one of these removed records was properly a NURKIN record and they are a fair representation of the NURKIN rile in general. Horsever, each and every one is involved in my requests and appeals on which you have not ested. I as saying that the PMI removed records that are material to appeals you have done nothing about.

Among the topics of the removal records are observe the PAI's records were moved top
what MSCA was investigating; that records it was excepting in Samplie; ticklers not
provided to set FOI Morale Datie; McDullough and the black firemen she were transferred
from the scene of the crime just before Dr. King was killed; the Clifton leini matter

For example, if you were to check the MURKIN file in evaluating my appeal you'd not find this pertinent record, and having been persuaded incorrectly by the FEE about matter this "changed to" indeps would not have may reason to go farther.

Serial 62244444 passes on projudicial information to SSCs, that the racist J.B.Stoner federally represented of indicated larger named Jesus Tratic Buckley. It also quotes Stoner as having said exactly what I informed ISD in 1969, leading to another FMI fabrication of defauation of me. Naturally this was basis enough for the HSCs to select, from all possible lawyers, only Buckley to represent Frs. Carol Papper, James Barl Ray's sister, when it refused to parall her to have counsel of her choice, Jim Least, (Nrs. Papper insisted she wanted lesser, after one experience with Buckley, he then persisted, HSCs backed down, and the 2 effort to frame her as a bag women who allegedly funnelled to her brother James, who she'd not seen since she was a baby, the many money her other brothers allegedly got in bank robberies, the FAI's conspiracy theory, satisfied collapsed.)
