

Dear Kim, re attached letter to Irving Jaffe, DJ, Civil 2/16/77

It is not an intra- or inter-agency records when then send FBI agents out to influence witnesses and in at least one case where the confession was made to Bill and me to fix them. This is some of what they did do in that litigation, in the first case. It was our main witness, the man who then worked for us. The agent they sent was related to him.

Their FOIA records go back to 718-70. Includes will be Eardley and Ruckelshaus files.

The reference to Jaffe's trip is to them loading up Departmental lawyers who were sick about letting the autopsy material and related records out and taking them to Baltimore for some back-stiffening by Fisher.

I did not say it but Jaffe's son knew all about it and was very, very uneasy about his father.

All of these records are included in my prior requests.

You will note that with the referral it is a month and a half.

However, there is a response in a month and a half whereas with me there is as yet no response.

If this proves anything it is that there is no backlog that has made response to my request impossible.

His own description is that I also am entitled to each and every one of these records.

They also have Civil records relating to my charges of perjury against DJ people and in the end, after I persisted, my complaint to Mitchell about FBI intrusions into my life and work were referred to Civil and are passed off in a letter I have from Ruckelshaus.

We do want all their files, don't we?
