This is in reply to your letter of 2 July 1977.

Based upon your request for access to any files retained by the U.S. Army Claims Service, your letter has been forwarded to that office for direct reply to you. The specific address is:

Chief, General Claims Division U. S. Army Claims Service Office of the Judge Advocate General Fort Meade, Maryland 20755

The letter of 1 July 1977 forwarded to you by this office released all documents in the Litigation Division files except those specifically noted which were forwarded to originating offices for release. This office cannot determine if all documents relevant to the discovery request (which was a part of one of your lawsuits) referenced in your letter are contained in the released documents. For example, discovery materials originally may have been forwarded to the United States Attorney (and Department of Justice). Litigation Division may not have retained a copy of those materials. Similarly, in closing or retiring the Litigation Division files (now combined as one file for storage), it may be that only selected documents were retained. Accordingly, the only candid response to your inquiry is that you were furnished a copy of all documents (except those forwarded to other offices for release) contained in the extant file.
