

JFK appeal - Paul Rothermel, Jr.
✓ PA appeal

Records relating to and originating from Rothermel are relevant to both the JFK case and my PA request. My prior appeals go back more than a year and have not been acted on yet. There is inconsistency in the earlier records provided in that what was withheld under one request was in part provided under the other. The nature of the incomplete release is defamatory, misrepresenting my views.

Page three seems to indicate that Rothermel was an informant of the Dallas Office at the time he was chief of security for H.L. Hunt. He provided information to the DFO in 1968, according to the records partly disclosed earlier.

Prior to the processing of these records there was a sensational series of cases and prosecutions. Criminal charges were placed against Hunts and Percy Foreman, who is charged with taking Hunt money to sell out a client (who could not afford Foreman) in a wire-tapping case in which the Hunts had Rothermel tapped and Rothermel, a former SA, caught them.

Part of the Hunt defense was that Rothermel was a federal informant.

The correct versions of the names on page 2 are Braden and Brading.

What was really referred to in this garbled information is factual -- the discovery of threats against the President prior to his going to Dallas. I have referred to the fact that these threats were known in connection with the William Walter matter.

There are relevant underlying records I have not seen in what was provided from FBIHQ and I am certain was not provided from Dallas files.
